It is a commodious structure, 136 feet long, 80 feet wide, and three stories high the lower story is of brown sand stone, the other two of red pressed brick with sandstone trim mings. This edifice is beautiful in architectural design, convenient in arrangement, and substantial in construction. Model School. - The building first used for school purposes was erected in 1886, is a one-story brick structure, 70 feet long and 60 feet wide, with a broad veranda entirely surrounding it, and a ten-foot hall extending through it from north to south. The building has been remodeled and completely furnished for a training school. It contains an assembly-room, teachers office and four class-rooms.
